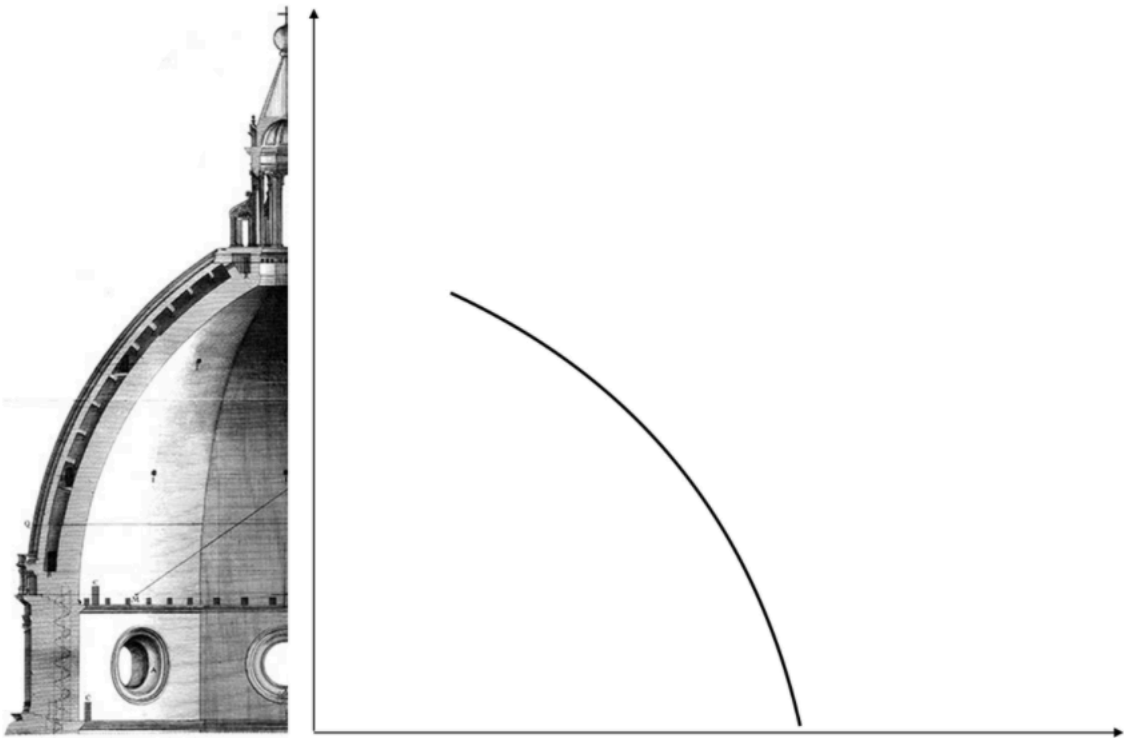

the meeting is two weeks from now, and we look forward to your participation.

We have a very nice set of talks – thank you! – and a message with scientific information will follow shortly.

The purpose of this message is to send important practical information to those who will come in person.

If you plan to attend remotely, you can skip the rest of this message!

Important information for in-person participants

* Registration and arrival/departure dates

We urge you to register if you haven't done so already. Please review and confirm/modify the information on attendance by March 15. It is crucial for us to have a response via the registration form, so that we can get a firm estimate of the number of people attending in person, and the Administration can send you the relevant papers.

* Reimbursement.

According to INFN and EU guidelines hotel expenses will be covered up to 120 Euro/night, and up to a maximum of five nights. From Tuesday to Friday lunches will be at the GGI. Dinner, and lunches not organised at the GGI will be reimbursed up to 30 Euros each, from Sunday evening till Friday evening.

Important: official receipts are needed for fiscal reasons.

A simple printout from an online booking site does not suffice.

which will be hosted by the Galileo Galilei Institute in Firenze, Italy from Monday, March 28, to Friday, April 1st 2022.

The main purpose of this message is to share some more information and to ask your feedback so we may prepare a draft program by early March.

Format

The meeting will be held in hybrid mode via the zoom platform for remote participants, and in the GGI main conference room for those who will be present. The registration form asks to choose between in-person and remote participation, but you may change this at a later stage. Talks could be given in either case, and the schedule will be unaffected if you decide to switch from remote to in-person participation, or vice-versa.

Program

The meeting will start on Monday March 28 2pm, and will end on Friday April 1st at Noon (times in CET). The program will include lattice topical talks and general talks from non-lattice specialists, aimed at a lattice audience. There will be a few discussion sessions. They will be mostly devoted to the

preparation of a Lattice White Paper, one of the deliverables of the Strong-2020 Lattice Network.

Depending on the number and on the interests of the in-person participants we will organise some sightseeing, or just leave room for strolling around – Spring is the ideal time of the year to do so.

Those who prefer not to give a talk are warmly invited to chair a session or to lead a discussion, to be agreed upon later on. Suggestions and comments are most welcome. Please let us have this information by February 28 so we may draft a tentative program to be posted on the web page.

We plan to circulate a general announcement at the beginning of March.

You are of course free to bring this workshop to the attention of anyone else who you might think is interested, including your junior collaborators and students.
